

...as young pretenders strut their stuff

While Kevin has had 18 months of rallying behind him Bothwell youngster Alick Kerr (17) was just setting out on his first forest stage rally in his Leaker Direct backed Peugeot 205 GTi.

“We were keen to get a finish under our belt to improve our seeding for future events but we were running last car and the stages were getting very rough by the time we passed through,” said Alick.

Despite this, he was fastest driver in

the Peugeot 205 Challenge on every stage but one and ended the rally more than 12 seconds in front of his nearest 205 rival.

A time penalty picked up at the start of stage three dropped Kerr back four places in the final standings but despite that, he still managed to pick up an award for the highest improvement in seeding which entitles him to a free entry into the next rally, Coltness Car Club's Colin McRae Forest Stages Rally in Perth on October 1.
