Bothwell's Alick Kerr (18), who is second overall in the Scottish Championship's two-wheel drive challenge with his Peugeot 205 GTi, and is also leading the series' Junior Championship, will look to consolidate his strong position in the championship, while trying to beat double Scottish champion Andrew Wood on 'a level playing field'.
