

### Three shortlisted for Mull scholarship

The three youngsters who are in contention to win a free entry on this year's Tunnocks Tour of Mull have been revealed.

Peugeot 205 drivers Ross Hunter, Alick Kerr and Chris Reid will be interviewed by a panel of judges later this week to determine which will be awarded the prestigious John Easson Scholarship.
