# Strong show despite mechanical problems

**BOTHWELL** rally driver Alick Kerr scored another strong result on his second outing in the Bags Online Subaru Impreza, finishing well on the Duns-based Jim Clark Reivers Rally.

The result boosts 20-year-old Kerr's standing in the Hankook Scottish Rally Championship as the season reaches its mid-point.

Nineteenth overall and 17th in class is where they finished, but had it not been for a couple of mechanical problems that slowed them, Kerr and co-driver Steven Brown would have finished in the top 10.

Even with these problems they still managed third and fifth-fastest times on two of the stages, run over closed



tarmac public roads in the Borders.
