

## MOTORSPORT: Weston's warm-up win

ABERDEEN'S Dave Weston jnr completed his build-up to next weekend's opening round of the British Rally Championship by cruising to a 27-second victory in the Border Counties Rally, the second round of the Hankook Scottish Championship.

The 19-year-old, quickest through two of the five stages, admitted his main objective had been to use the 45-mile event to get more test miles in his new 2010 Subaru Impreza.

"Winning is really a bonus," said Weston jnr, whose father, also Dave, is a former Scottish champion. "Our priority is the British Championship."

With Weston jnr not registered for

the Scottish Championship, Oban's Shaun Sinclair took maximum points after finishing second overall in his Mitsubishi Evo IX.

Defending Scottish champion David Bogie, who will also tackle the opening British round next weekend, finished second highest SRC points scorer in his Mitsubishi Evo IX.

Bothwell's Alick Kerr, fifth overall and fourth-fastest Scottish Championship-registered driver in his Impreza, leads the title race.

□ Fife's Gordon Shedden will return to the British Touring Car Championship this year in a works-backed Honda Civic, partnering double BTCC champion Matt Neal.
